Steps


- 1. Kindness to Self

Step 2 Kindness to Others

Choices—Do One

☐ Create an EMOTION board—Brainstorm with your troop/ others different emotion words, good characteristics and/ or qualities.

- Use post-it notes, labels, tape, etc. to print on the display.
- Troop members will take/wear an emotion.
- Have a troop discussion about the feelings and help them to understand how to have compassion for all others.
 Def: empathy—n. the quality or process of entering fully, through imagination, into another's feelings or motives.

□ Notes/Pictures/Letters

- Where is there a need for kindness to others?
- Have your troop/others create a drive to write/draw to others. Family/Friends

Elderly—Assisted living, retirement homes, and hospitals Hospitals—children's, rehab, cancer centers, etc.


Others

Book Sharing

- As a troop collect books to share with others.
- Do research to find the need of books or printed materials for others.
- Create a lending library as a troop—Leave a book. Take a book!
- Community Book Houses—A mailbox type container/box with a glass front on a pole—decorated and designated as a Book House for all to enjoy. (This will be an ongoing project so prepare for long range planning.)

Step 3 Kindness to Animals

Choices—Do One

□ Animal Rescues in Your Area

- What materials can you gather/donate to the rescue?
- Have a shelter volunteer visit your troop.

☐ World Animals and Zoos

- Research how your troop could raise awareness, money, or supplies for a world animal.
- Research endangered animals to raise awareness for their future. Report your research to your troop.
- Adopt a zoo animal or raise money to give a facility for a specific animal.
- Look on the web for live cams in zoos and others facilities for your research.
- What impact could you and your troop have on these animals?

☐ Organize a Drive to Help a Humane Organization.

- Do research on how your troop can help animals.
- Collect pet food, old towels, pet toys, newspapers, and other items for the organization.

Step 4 Kindness to Earth

Choices—Do One

□ Recycling Project:

- Organize your troop to create recycling awareness.
- Do research about the meaning of the recycling symbols.

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- Create an area for recycling in a school, church, or other place. Organize daily/weekly pick-up and delivery of the recyclables.
- You can make this a weekly and/or monthly project.

☐ Clean the Earth:

• Do research in your area of a place to be cleaned up for the environment.

- Possible areas: creeks, watershed areas, rivers, lakes, overgrown lawns/parks, etc.
- Organize your troop/friends with safety gear for the event: gloves, correct shoes, trash bags, etc.
- Prepare an area for the bags and safe removal of the collected trash.

What impact will your project mean for the environment? Report to other troops, Girl Scout Council, and media.


☐ Create a Campaign for Re-usable Bags:

- Research plastic bag usage on the environment.
- Design reusable bags—size, material, artwork/graphics and cost.

Raise money to create the bags.

Distribute/sell the bags. Decide on an environmental use for money raised.

Choices—Do One


- ☐ Organize Your Troop to Be a Positive Role Model
