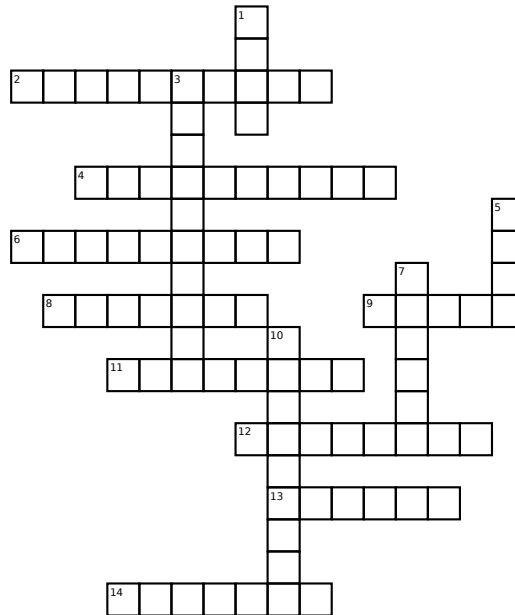


# Moozie's Orchestra Adventure

### Down:

1. a piece of thin cane or metal, sometimes doubled, that vibrates in a current of air to produce the sound of various musical instruments, as in the mouthpiece of a clarinet or oboe
3. musical instruments played by striking with the hand or with a handheld or pedal-operated stick or beater, or by shaking, including drums, cymbals, xylophones, gongs, bells, and rattles
5. a woodwind instrument with a double-reed mouthpiece, a slender tubular body, and holes stopped by keys
7. not existing before; made, introduced, or discovered recently or now for the first time
10. a practice or trial performance of a play or
